Finding: The Marple Newtown School District failed to require placement agencies to fully complete placement letters for all foster students educated by the district during the 2012-2013 through 2015-2016 school years.

Corrective Action: The Marple Newtown School District concurs with this finding and immediately took the following corrective action when identified by the auditor:

- At the time of registration, guardians/foster agency will identify if they receive any compensation for any students enrolled as foster students in the MNSD.
- All placement letters will identify if the foster student's resident guardian is receiving compensation for keeping the student.
- Constant communication between the Registrar and PIMS coordinator to ensure the students are accurately reported in the Student Information System (SIS).
- The Home and School Visitor will validate residency prior to submission to PDE. The Home and School Visitor, Registrar and PIMS Coordinator will continue to monitor foster care students within the district.
