Dear Mr. Loucks and Ms. Bard:

We conducted a Limited Procedures Engagement (LPE) of the Forbes Road School District (District) to determine its compliance with certain relevant state laws, regulations, policies, and administrative procedures. The LPE covers the period December 14, 2011 through April 27, 2015, except for any areas of compliance that may have required an alternative to this period. The engagement was conducted pursuant to authority derived from Article VIII, Section 10 of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the Fiscal Code 72 P.S. § 403, but was not conducted in accordance with *Government Auditing Standards* issued by the Comptroller General of the United States.

As we conducted our LPE procedures, we sought to determine answers to the following questions, which serve as our LPE objectives:

- Did the District have documented board policies and administrative procedures related to the following?
  - o Internal controls
  - o Budgeting practices
  - o The Right-to-Know Law
  - The Sunshine Law
- Were the policies and procedures adequate and appropriate, and have they been properly implemented?
- Did the District comply with the relevant requirements in the Right-to-Know Law and the Sunshine Law?
- Did the District take appropriate corrective action to address the finding made in our prior audit, and were the actions taken into effect?

## **Status of Prior Findings and Observations**

# **Finding**

Errors in Reporting Non-resident Membership Resulted in Underpayments of \$25,705 in Tuition for Children Placed in Private Homes (Foster Children)

#### Finding Condition

Our prior audit found that for the 2008-09 school year membership was understated by 179 days, resulting in an underpayment of \$8,794. For the 2009-10 school year membership for non-resident elementary foster children was understated by 358 days, resulting in an underpayment in Commonwealth-paid tuition for foster children of \$16,911. The total of the underpayments for the two school years amounted to \$25,705.

#### Recommendation

Our finding recommended that the District should:

- 1. Review membership reports thoroughly prior to submission to the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) to ensure all nonresident membership is properly reported.
- 2. Review reports submitted subsequent to the years audited and submit revised reports to PDE, if errors are found.
- 3. Ensure personnel, who are assigned the responsibility of membership, obtain the proper training.

We also recommended that PDE should:

4. Adjust the District's allocations to correct the underpayments of \$25,705.

## **Current Status**

Our current audit found that the District implemented our recommendations. As of completion of our fieldwork, PDE did not adjust the District's allocations recommended in our previous audit.
