We conducted a Limited Procedures Engagement (LPE) of the Bedford County Technical Center (Center) to determine its compliance with certain relevant state laws, regulations, policies, and administrative procedures (relevant requirements). The LPE covers the period July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2015. The engagement was conducted pursuant to authority derived from Article VIII, Section 10 of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and The Fiscal Code, 72 P.S. § 403, but was not conducted in accordance with *Government Auditing Standards* issued by the Comptroller General of the United States.

As we conducted our LPE procedures, we sought to determine answers to the following questions, which serve as our LPE objectives:

- Did the Center have documented board policies and administrative procedures related to the following?
 - o Internal controls
 - Budgeting practices
 - o The Right-to-Know Law
 - o The Sunshine Law
- Were the policies and procedures adequate and appropriate, and have they been properly implemented?
- Did the Center comply with the relevant requirements in the Right-to-Know Law and the Sunshine Law?
- Did the Center take appropriate corrective action to address the observation made in our prior audit, and were the actions taken into effect?

Status of Prior Findings and Observations

Prior Observation

District Needs to Establish Separate Information Technology Policies and Procedures

Prior Observation Condition

Our prior audit found that the Center uses an outside vendor to provide system maintenance and support for its critical student accounting applications (membership and attendance). The outside vendor has remote access into the Center's network servers. We determined that a risk existed that unauthorized changes to the Center's data could occur and not be detected because the Center did not have current information technology (IT) policies and procedures for controlling the activities of the vendor.

Prior Recommendations

Our prior audit observation recommended that the Center should:

- 1. Establish separate IT policies and procedures for controlling the activities of vendors/consultants and have the vendor sign this policy.
- 2. Keep on file a copy of the fully executed maintenance agreement, signed by both parties.

Current Status

Our current audit determined that the Center did implement the recommendations made in our prior audit. The Center did establish separate IT policies and procedures for controlling the activities of vendors/consultants and these policies and procedures are signed by the vendor. The Center also had on file a signed copy of the executed maintenance agreement with the vendor.
