Auditor General DePasquale to Hold Town Hall Meeting to Listen, Discuss Ideas for Improving Public Schools in Scranton

HARRISBURG – Auditor General Eugene DePasquale today invited the Scranton community to a town hall meeting on Jan. 23 to discuss ideas for improving public schools.

"I want to hear directly from students, teachers, and parents about how we can come together as a community to improve public schools," DePasquale said.

"It's time we give the community a chance to be heard and discuss their ideas that could move public education forward in Scranton and focus on educating students.

"We are reaching a critical point where major public education decisions are being made that affect the entire community, and I want to hear directly from the people most affected," he said.
