Make A Moon Jar



What's a moon jar?

A moon jar is a tool that helps you save money. It has three sections labeled "save," "spend" and "share." When you earn money, you can put it in each compartment and watch your money grow!

What do I need?

A small container (like a paper yogurt cup), construction paper or cardstock for a divider, tape, markers and stickers.

How do I make it?

- ① Cut your construction paper or cardstock into three pieces that fit inside your container. Write "spend," "save" and "share" on each piece of paper to label your sections. Tip: use your tape to stick the pieces together!
- ② Insert the divider into the container – now you have three sections.
- ③ On the outside of the container, decorate, write or draw what you're saving your money for, spending your money on and who you're sharing your money with.
- ④ As you earn money, place it in each section and watch how quickly it adds up!
